



The University of Utah American Indian Science and Engineering Society (AISES) Chapter and iUTAH are pleased to announce that it will be accepting applications for participant support (up to \$500) to the 2015 AISES Joint Regions 1 & 3 Conference being held in Salt Lake City, UT from March 5-7, 2015 at the University Guest House and Conference Center.

Applicants MUST meet all of the following criteria:

1. Must be a part-time or full-time student in Alaska, Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, New Mexico, Oregon, Utah, Washington, Wyoming, and Canada (Alberta, British Columbia, Saskatchewan, and Yukon Territory)
2. Must be a member of an American Indian tribe or otherwise considered to be an American Indian by the tribe with which affiliation is claimed; or is Alaskan Native; or considered to be an Alaskan Native by an Alaskan Native group to which affiliation is claimed; or is a Native Hawaiian; or is a First Nations member.

How to apply:

1. Complete and submit application
2. Complete and submit statement about the value of attending the 2015 AISES Joint Regions 1 & 3 Conference
3. Submit enrollment verification for Fall 2014 and Spring 2015 class schedule when available

Participant support covered

1. Round trip airfare or train travel or mileage from home university to Salt Lake City, UT, student will purchase and submit receipt for reimbursement.
2. Hotel accommodations (March 5-7, 2015), University of Utah AISES will purchase directly; students will be assigned a roommate to keep costs down.
3. Registration fee, University of Utah AISES will purchase directly

Expenses not covered

Participant support DOES NOT cover membership fees, baggage fees, travel itinerary change fees, meals purchased outside of conference, and parking fees. Ground transportation to/from the airport/train station or hotel are the student's responsibility. U of U AISES will only provide lodging for three (3) nights on March 5-7, 2015. Students' travel days will be Thursday, March 5, 2015 and Sunday, March 8, 2015. Students are expected to attend all events and to abide by the [AISES Code of Conduct](#).
